## **President's Report on the 2008 – 2009 Season**

It is with pleasure I present the 39<sup>th</sup> Year annual report of the Tautuku Fishing Club.

It's been challenging in a difficult financial Year of World uncertainty. We have shown even figures financially this Year, with increase reserves in our bank investments and current account. As stated last year our major focus is on our Club future. Your Committee has been fully aware of increase running costs involved in maintaining the Clubhouse and has 'saved' where possible. To operate one of New Zealand's most prestigious Fishing Clubs; we have to meet our business obligations. Yes we are a 'business', as we are an Incorporated Society and GST registered.

A letter from your Committee creating awareness for 'moving forward' will be discussed at this AGM. I feel a 'steering' Committee should be considered; look at all possibilities for our Club future and then bring their findings to a extra special meeting for members to decide. It is with vital importance that we have a planned 'business plan' for future Club survival.

With Grants and Fund Raising so vital for our Club needs; we have created a Grants Managers position – thanks to Stewart Springer in continuing his sterling work in this position.

Many thanks to all our Sponsors who have helped towards Club Fishing Events, Club Social Events, maintenance needs, general running of the Club, and the many Sponsors that support our annual 'public' Anniversary Fishing Competition. I urge all members to consider our Sponsors when making personal purchases. With the ongoing uncertainty of 'recession outlook', we should be supporting our members who have their Own Businesses – support each other here.

Congratulations to our Club Trophy Winners for the Season, and those who achieved New Zealand awards during the National Competitions. Thanks to our Club Captain, Anniversary Fishing Competition Co-ordinator and Fishing Committee, in staging various interesting fishing events over the Season, recording activities and the momentum is increasing for substantial prizes for the 2009/10 Fishing Calendar.
